

TEXAS MASTER GARDENER PROGRAM PLANNED

Thank you for your interest in the Anderson County Master Gardener program. *Please read this letter carefully, complete and sign the enclosed application* and return it to the address at the bottom of the application form by January 2, 2020. All applications must be returned to Anderson County Extension Office.

Master Gardener Program is designed by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service a part of Texas A&M University System. The office of Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service Anderson County will sponsor the Anderson County Master Gardener Program.

The following information will help you better understand the functions and requirements of the Texas Master Gardener program.

The Master Gardener Program is a volunteer development program offered by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service. This program is designed to increase the availability of horticultural information and improve the quality of life through horticultural projects. Program objectives are implemented through the training and "employing" local volunteers, known as Master Gardeners. They aid Extension by conducting school garden projects, answering telephone requests for horticultural information, establishing and maintaining demonstration gardens, working with special audiences in the community, and designing and implementing community improvement projects as well as coordinating Master Gardener projects. The program offers a minimum of seventy (70) hours of instruction that covers topics including lawn care, ornamental trees and shrubs, insects, disease and weed management, soils and plant nutrition, vegetable gardening, home fruit production, garden flowers and water conservation and also will include field trips. You must devote a minimum of fifty (50) hours of Master Gardener volunteer services in Anderson County, twenty (20) of those hours have to be in the Extension Office answering Horticulture questions.

Some of these hours may be in the field of your choice, while some may be assigned according to the needs of the community and the Extension Horticulture program. You have up to twelve (12) months to complete Volunteer Service.

Persons that are interested in the Master Gardener Program are ask to fill out an application. The registration fee for the Texas Master Gardener course is \$160.00, this fee covers the Master Gardener Handbook and other reference materials. Orientation for Master Gardener trainees begins at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, January 13th and the 1st class will be Tuesday, January 14th at the Anderson County Extension Office. After the first class and orientation all other classes will start at 8:30 a.m. and end at 12:00 p.m. Some of the classes may not end at 12:00 p.m. There will be three or four out town field days. There will also be 3 classes conducted in Tyler, Texas. All applications must be returned to the Anderson County Extension Office no later than January 2, 2020. All applicants should attend the meeting.
