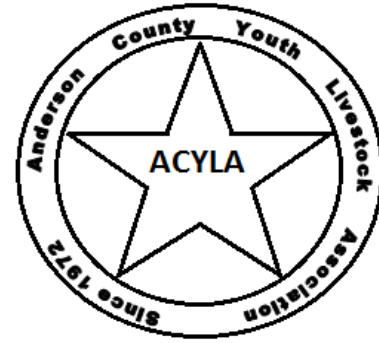

Dear Anderson County Youth Livestock Supporter,

I hope this letter finds you and your family COVID-19 free, safe, and healthy. I'm sure that most of you know that we had to cancel our April 19 – 23, 2020 Anderson County Youth Livestock Show because of the virus. All of our show families are heartbroken by the cancelation, especially the kids who have worked so hard all year for the opportunity to show and market their projects. Without the Livestock Show, there can be no Premium Auction, and no way for these exhibitors to recoup the money they have invested in developing their projects.

We are reaching out to you and asking for your help and continued support of Anderson County's agricultural youth.

We would like to ask you to support ACYLA in establishing a "pool" of funds that will be distributed among the exhibitors. The pool will be distributed as follows: steer exhibitors will share 20% of the pool, commercial heifer exhibitors will share 20% of the pool, swine exhibitors will share 15% of the pool, goat exhibitors will share 15% of the pool, lamb exhibitors will share 15% of the pool, rabbit exhibitors will share 7.5% of the pool, and broiler exhibitors will share 7.5% of the pool.

As always, you can also "add on" to a particular exhibitor, or several exhibitors.

ACYLA will not be taking a commission on your donations, as we do with the Premium Auction. Instead, the exhibitors will receive 100% of the money donated.

Attached you will find a form that allows you to tell us if you want to make a donation to the "pool" fund or if you would like to "add-on" to a specific exhibitor, or both. Please send your payment with the form. Upon receipt of your donation, a receipt will be mailed to you for your tax purposes.

As always, we, The Anderson County Youth Livestock Association, appreciate your support, and continued support of the youth of Anderson County.
